

The following disclosure is for California residents on behalf of Foursight Capital, LLC (“Foursight”). The terms “we”, “our” and “us” in this policy refer to Foursight. “You”, “them” and “your” refer to California residents.

Overview

This notice explains how we collect, use, and disclose personal information about California residents. This notice also explains certain rights California residents have under the California Consumer Privacy Act (“CCPA”). Under the CCPA, “Personal Information” is information that identifies, relates to, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with any particular California resident or household. The CCPA however, does not apply to certain information, such as information subject to the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (“GLBA”).

This notice explains the types of Personal Information collected and how California residents can exercise their rights under the CCPA to request that we provide certain personal information that we may have collected about them during the previous 12 months.

Collection of Personal Information

In the past 12 months, depending on our relationship or interactions with you, we may have collected and disclosed to third parties the following types of Personal Information covered by this disclosure:

- Identifiers, such as full name and federal or state issued identification numbers, including social security number, driver’s license number and/or passport number
- Personal contact information such as telephone numbers and address, financial information, payment card details
- Characteristics of protected classes under state or federal law, such as sex or marital status
- Purchase information, such as products or services obtained and transaction histories
- Internet or network activity, such as browsing history and interactions with our website
- Audio, electronic, visual, thermal, olfactory, or similar information
- Professional or employment-related information
- Education information
- Inferences drawn from any of the Personal Information listed above to create a profile about an individual’s characteristics or preferences

The following are categories of sources from whom Personal Information is collected:

- Directly from you or your representatives
- Service providers, consumer data resellers and other third parties
- Public records sources
- Information from our Affiliates
- Website activity, social media

The categories of third parties to whom we disclose Personal Information for our business purposes

- Affiliates and Subsidiaries of Foursight
- Vendors and Service Providers who provide services (such as website hosting, payment processing, information technology, email delivery, and auditing)

- Partners and Third Parties who provide services such as payment, banking, communication, storage, legal expertise, tax expertise, notaries and auditors
- Third Parties who enable customers to conduct transactions online
- Government or Legal Agencies as required by laws and regulations

Sale of Personal Information

In the preceding 12 months, we have not sold, or otherwise disclosed any Personal Information subject to the CCPA, to any third party for monetary or other valuable consideration.

Right to Request Deletion of Personal Information

CCPA gives you the right to request deletion of your Personal Information. However, please keep in mind that Foursight is not legally required to honor your request for deletion if the Personal Information is necessary for a business purpose.

Exercising your Rights

Only you, or a person registered with the California Secretary of State whom you authorize to act on your behalf, may make a verifiable request related to your Personal Information. You may only make a verifiable consumer request twice within a 12-month period.

For a verifiable request, you must be able to:

- Describe your request with sufficient detail to allow us to properly understand, evaluate, and respond; and
- Provide sufficient information to allow to reasonably verify you are the California resident about whom we collected Personal Information. The information you provide must include:
 - Confirmation of California residency
 - Full Name
 - Address
 - Email address
 - Any other information which authenticates you (if you are a customer) or verifies you (if you are a non-customer)

Non-Discrimination Rights

You have the right to not be discriminated against for exercising your privacy rights conferred you by the CCPA.
